Have you heard about the new program starting at Pleasant Hill? It is called J.A.M. Sessions. This J.A.M. isn't something you'd have on toast, it stands for "Jesus And Me". Education and Worship teams are working together to provide a Christian education opportunity for kids who aren't able to attend Sunday School in person.

Starting September 10, J.A.M. Sessions will replace our current One Room Sunday School. There will still be in-person learning after children's time but J.A.M. Sessions will also be posted on our website, www.pleasanthillumc.org. Everyone signed up will receive a monthly packet containing the lessons that will be led by Miss Lauren. The curriculum follows the UMC liturgy and includes videos, puzzles, crafts, and daily discussion questions.

This gives kids who aren't able to come to church regularly due to other activities an opportunity to continue to grow their relationship with Jesus. It also gives kids who can attend a chance to hear more about what they heard at church. Everyone, no matter your age, can watch the online sessions. 


