And please let us know of any pastoral care needs you might have, for we do want to be there for you. It would be a blessing to increase our group of ambassadors for Christ in providing care to our congregation. This truly is an opportunity to be the hands and feet of Christ. It doesn't take a great amount of time from your busy schedules and the rewards are so fulfilling for all of us.

The first Sunday in October is designated as World Communion Sunday, which celebrates our oneness in Christ with all our brothers and sisters around the world. United Methodist congregations join many Christian churches across the globe in celebrating World Communion Sunday, which began at Shadyside Presbyterian Church in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania in 1933.

It is a day to remember that Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church and that every Christian church and any denomination that promotes Christian unity are one. On this day, people draw faith and inspiration from seeing that they are part of a community that boasts millions of believers and worshippers. World Wide Communion symbolizes the effort to hold things together, in a spiritual sense. It emphasizes that we are one in the Spirit and the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

We observe communion to commemorate a past event, to anticipate a future event, and to participate in the celebration of life between the two.

Holy Communion joins us in Christian unity. This sacrament invites us to focus on the holiness of communion with God and one another. United Methodists, in conjunction with other denominations and believers worldwide, participate in communion to recognize our unity in Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. This universal and inclusive connection is the foundation for World Communion Sunday.


