Pastor's Corner

This year's Annual Conference in Kearney, NE was one of the most hopeful and joyful conferences ever experienced by me in over 35 years of attending. It was a wonderful mix of getting the business done and celebrating 10 years as a conference. You may remember that the Kansas East, Kansas West and Nebraska conferences united in Salina in 2014.

Worship services were beautifully done. The opening worship was the communion service, followed by an anniversary cake for everyone. The Memorial service honored and remembered 41 pastors, 28 clergy



spouses, 1 clergy child, one conference staff person, and one former conference lay leader. Three baptisms of clergy children were celebrated with Bishop Wilson officiating. The youth service was creative and energetic and the ordination service was meaningful as always. The retirement of 35 clergy was recognized on the floor of conference and at a dinner Friday night. Thirteen elders were ordained and 10 provisional members were commissioned Saturday morning in the ordination service.

There was a special offering received to provide drinking water to the Santee Sioux Nation Reservation in northern Nebraska. The reservation has been without clean drinking water since 2019. Over \$8,000 was received, enough to provide 2 semi tanker truckloads of drinking water!

Friday featured a recap of General Conference by our delegation. Five lay delegates to Jurisdictional Conference were elected on the first ballot. Churches celebrating milestone anniversaries were also recognized and presented plaques and certificates.

New district alignments were approved. Currently we have 17 districts, with most district superintendents covering two districts. The new alignment, effective July 1, 2024, will be 10 districts. The current name of our district is the Topeka district, and after July 1, we will become the East Central Kansas district. Rev. Jenny Collins will remain our District Superintendent.

Along the way, various reports were heard from committees and agencies that we are affiliated with, and awards and scholarships were presented. So much good work and important ministry is being done in local churches as well as across United Methodism. It was good to hear and learn!


